## **LifeReady FAQ**

(frequently asked questions)

### **This program is held at Harrison Hills but I am a Buckeye Local student, may I participate?**

The program is open to all soph, jun, and sen residents of Harrison County. Your home school is irrelevant, but you will need to participate actively.

### **I'm a senior and play girls volleyball, but want to complete the program. What are my options?**

You will need to be diligent, but *can* complete at the bronze level. Look at the schedule. You will complete the two "on your own" events in the fall trimester (during your volleyball season), fully attend winter and spring trimesters. This will give you 18 attended sessions which equals a bronze level of completion.

### **You mentioned during the information night that if a college I am interested in is not on the partner list, you will ask them to become one. How does that work?**

Colleges make their scholarship pool decisions one full year+ in advance. So, if you are a Sophomore or Junior in the LifeReady program and are 99% certain you want to attend a non-partner college like, say, Otterbein, you can inform us and we will ask Otterbein if they want in. For Seniors, it is usually too late but we would still investigate on your behalf...schools really want well-prepared students like you!

### **I'm only an average student. Is this program for me?**

If you are motivated enough to join our program, we can help to motivate you to be your best academically. Ultimately, our role is to help each student find the right path for them. If you are accepted at one of our partner colleges, your grades will not affect your ability to receive a LifeReady scholarship.
